TRAVEL REMINDER

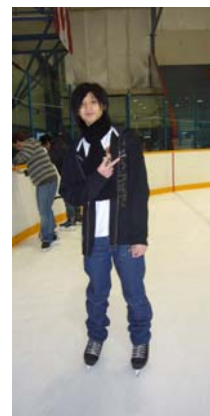
