Do you know which countries celebrated Asian or Lunar New Year on Jan.26th?



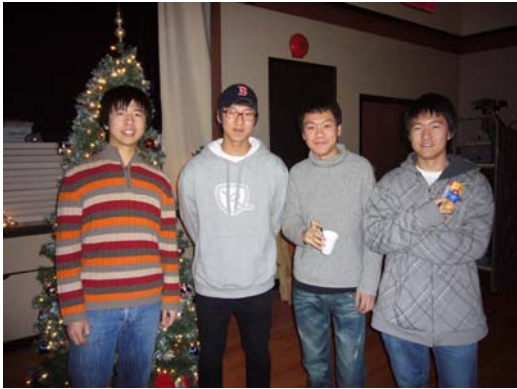
